Class 1: Stallions (must be fully licensed)

Class 2: Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 3: Two Year Old Filly or Gelding

Class 4: Three Year Old Filly or Gelding

Class 5: Geldings, 4 years and over

Class 6: Mares without foal at foot, 4 years and over

Class 7: Mare with foal at foot

Class 8: Foal, to be at least 3 weeks old on show day and eligible for registration in the Fell Pony Stud Book)

**Special a)** Youngstock Championship (1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 2,3 ,4 & 8)

**Special b)** Adult Championship (1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 1, 5,6, & 7)

Class 9: Stallion (must be fully licensed)

Class 10: Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 11: Two year old Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 12: Three year old Filly or Gelding

Class 13: Geldings 4 years and over

Class 14: Geld Mare (without foal at foot)

Class 15: Mare with foal at foot

Class 16: Foal (To be at least 3 weeks old on show day and eligible for registration in the Dales Pony Stud Book)

Class 17: Registered Part Bred Dales, any age.

Class 21: Equitation - **Only for ponies not entered in an open ridden class**  
(to be judged on style and performance under saddle )

Class 22: Ridden Veteran (Pony to be 18 years and over)

Open to Fell and Dales ponies 1st-6th Rosettes for each breed.

Special for the highest score in each class.

## **SHOW RULES**

Exhibitors must be current members of either or both of the Fell Pony Society and the Dales Pony Society, and the showing rules of each Society apply to the appropriate classes. Classes are only open to ponies registered in the Fell Pony stud book and Dales Pony stud book or Part Bred register.

The current showing rules of each Breed Society apply to the appropriate classes. Please contact the Breed Society concerned for a copy.

The organisers reserve the right to combine or divide any class as necessary. Efforts will be made to prevent classes clashing, but in the event of a clash, classes will not be held up and the exhibitor must decide which to enter.

**COMPLAINTS:** We do not encourage complaints. This is intended as a fun show, to be enjoyed by all. If you really must complain, your complaint must be accompanied by a fee of £20.00, which will only be returned if the complaint is upheld.

### Directions to Bakewell Showground

#### From Sheffield and Chesterfield

Approach Bakewell on the A619 from Baslow. On reaching Bakewell, turn left into Station Road just before the bridge, and then immediately right into Coombs Road. Carry on along Coombs road past the car park and the houses, and then a further stretch, until you get to the farm on the right. The Showground entrance is immediately after the farm.

#### From Matlock

Go into Bakewell on the A6. Turn right at the roundabout by the Rutland Arms Hotel. Follow this straight through the one way system and over the bridge and turn immediately right into Station Road and then immediately right again into Coombs Road. Carry on along Coombs road past the car park and the houses, and then a further stretch, until you get to the farm on the right. The Showground entrance is immediately after the farm.

#### From Buxton

Go into Bakewell on the A6. Turn left at the roundabout by the Rutland Arms Hotel. Follow this straight through the one way system and over the bridge and turn immediately right into Station Road and then immediately right again into Coombs Road. Carry on along Coombs road past the car park and the houses, and then a further stretch, until you get to the farm on the right. The Showground entrance is immediately after the farm.
