COUNCIL MATTERS

Recent Council Decisions - New Regulations

At the Council Meeting on 17th August 1999 various decisions, having been discussed at length and in depth were agreed. All decisions received 15 votes in favour with only 2 abstentions on one of the proposals.

The Decisions were:

A) Daughter Societies - Exportation

All ponies sold after 1st October 1999 for export will need to have DNA samples taken from the pony and both parents. The DNA samples can be collected by the breeders/owners and the results are `usually analysed quickly.

Therefore, ponies being exported from this country will need Parent age Confirmation Certificates before leaving the UK. Otherwise, they will not then be recognised by the FPS Mother Stud Book.

It is the responsibility of the vendor to inform the purchaser about the Society rules, in case the purchaser is not knowledgeable of such rules. It is then totally the responsibility of the purchaser to make sure that our rules are complied with before each pony is exported from the UK. Transfer certificates will be amended with this information. Ponies sold before 1/10/1999 but not being shipped abroad until later this year will only need to DNA test the pony itself. This is to allow the vendor to add the expenses onto the purchase price.

B) Identification

All filly foals are to be DNA tested from next year. Colts will be done at the time of licensing as already exists. The cost of the first three filly foals to be DNA tested will be born by the breeder. Thereafter the FPS will pay for additional filly foal tests. Such DNA tests are to be done before the foal is weaned from it's dam.

C) Random Testing

It was agreed that random DNA testing of ponies to check their parentage would be appropriate to the Fell Pony Society. The detail of such random sampling is yet to be clarified.

The Regulations of the Society as issued in January 1999, with regard to these decisions, will be reviewed and issued with appropriate amendments in due course. Clarification of these procedures can be explained by consultation with the Society's Secretary.

MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND AUCTION SALE

All vendors must complete a Certificate of Transfer form in respect of each pony being sold to be handed in with the Registration Certificate to the Secretary **before** the sale begins.

Most of the foal documents have been returned to the owners, but any outstanding ones will be taken straight to the sale.

Penrith Farmers & Kidd's plc at Skirsgill Agricultural Hall will have the catalogue of ponies entered in this year's auction available ten days before the sale which is on 22nd October.

The pre-sale judge this year is Mr J Bell of Waverhead.

SALES AND EXHIBITIONS

Due to the illness of Mrs Molly Laing, Peter and Pauline Forsman have taken over the responsibility for Sales and Exhibition. Some new merchandising lines have been purchased and proved so popular they have had to re-order already. The new lines were also in great demand with the Southern Members at the Southern Breed Show. Further plans are afoot for next year, and even more importantly the stands at shows this year have been very profitable and well worth the work that has been involved. Thank you very much to Peter and Pauline, also for their valuable removal techniques over the summer! During the winter more Desk Top Publishing and archieving will be tackled, ready for more visual displays next summer.
