SHOW RULES: PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING:

- 1 The Fell Pony Society will not be responsible for any accidents which may occur on the show field. Entries are accepted subject to this condition. Exhibitors are advised that all ponies should be insured for public liability.
- 2 This show is held under the Rules found in the FPS Handbook for Showing and Competing.
- 3 Only paid up current Fell Pony Society members are eligible to enter. Membership Subscriptions for 2025 must therefore have been paid.
- 4 Entries: £12 per entry.
Entry forms to be completed and forwarded with entry fees (cheques payable to The Fell Pony Society) to The Fell Pony Society Office, Bank House, Boroughgate, Appleby, Cumbria CA16 6XF. Telephone 017683 53100
Closing Date for Entries 27 October 2025. No entries accepted after this date. (no entries will be taken on the day). Entries will be taken at the FPS sale.
- 5 For all classes, rosettes will be awarded to 6th place with prize money issued after the show, within 4 weeks, by bank transfer where possible: 1st - £10, 2nd - £8, and 3rd - £6. Alternatively, prize money can be paid by cheque after the show on receipt of a sae. If either bank details or a sae are not provided then the prize money due will be treated as a donation to the Fell Pony Society.
- 6 Exhibitors are asked not to enter classes judged by their pony's breeder. A judge may not judge a pony which holds his/her prefix or which has been bred by his/her immediate family. If the judge finds that, inadvertently, such a situation should arise, he/she should ask the steward to call the reserve judge into the ring to place the pony in question.
- 7 Any objection or complaint must be made in writing in accordance with the Complaints and Disciplinary Procedure.

8 **Please note** that all foals entered for the show must have been registered with the Fell Pony Society and issued with a FPS passport prior to show day. Passport applications must be submitted to the Society's office by no later than 20 October 2025.

9 Exhibitors' contact details, name, address & telephone numbers will be printed in the catalogue unless otherwise requested. You will be asked to sign a declaration on the entry form to agree to your contact details being published in the catalogue for this show and that the results of the show will be displayed in the public domain by the FPS and may be forwarded onto 3rd parties including the press.

10 By entering the show venue on 2 November, all persons are acknowledging that photographic images and / or audio, visual and / or audio-visual recordings and / or feeds (and or stills taken from them) may be taken of them and may be used, by way of example and without limitation, for promotional, editorial or marketing purposes of the Fell Pony society or others. Entry to the show field constitutes consent to such use.
